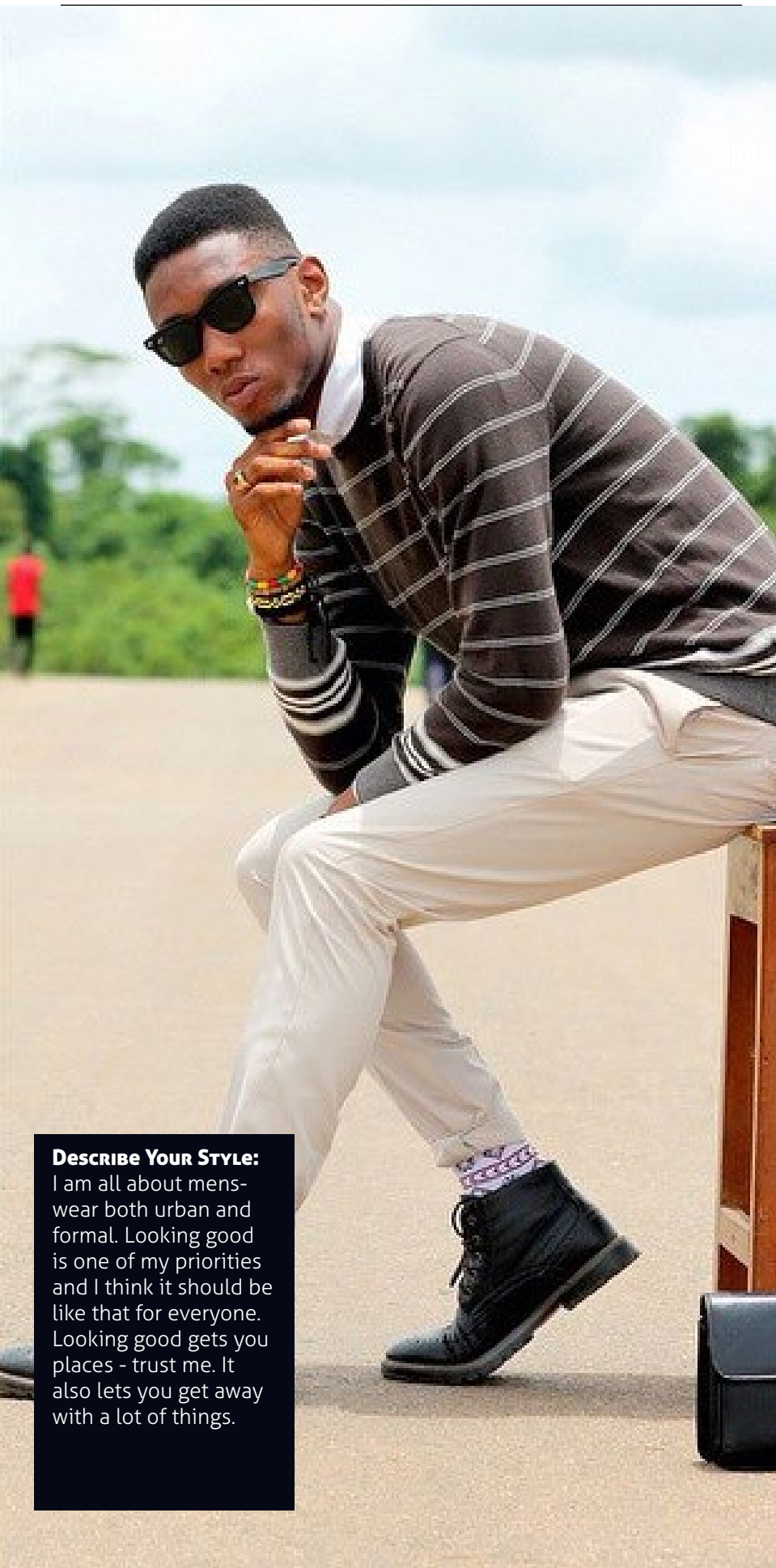

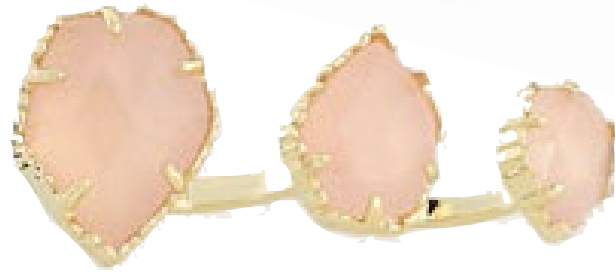

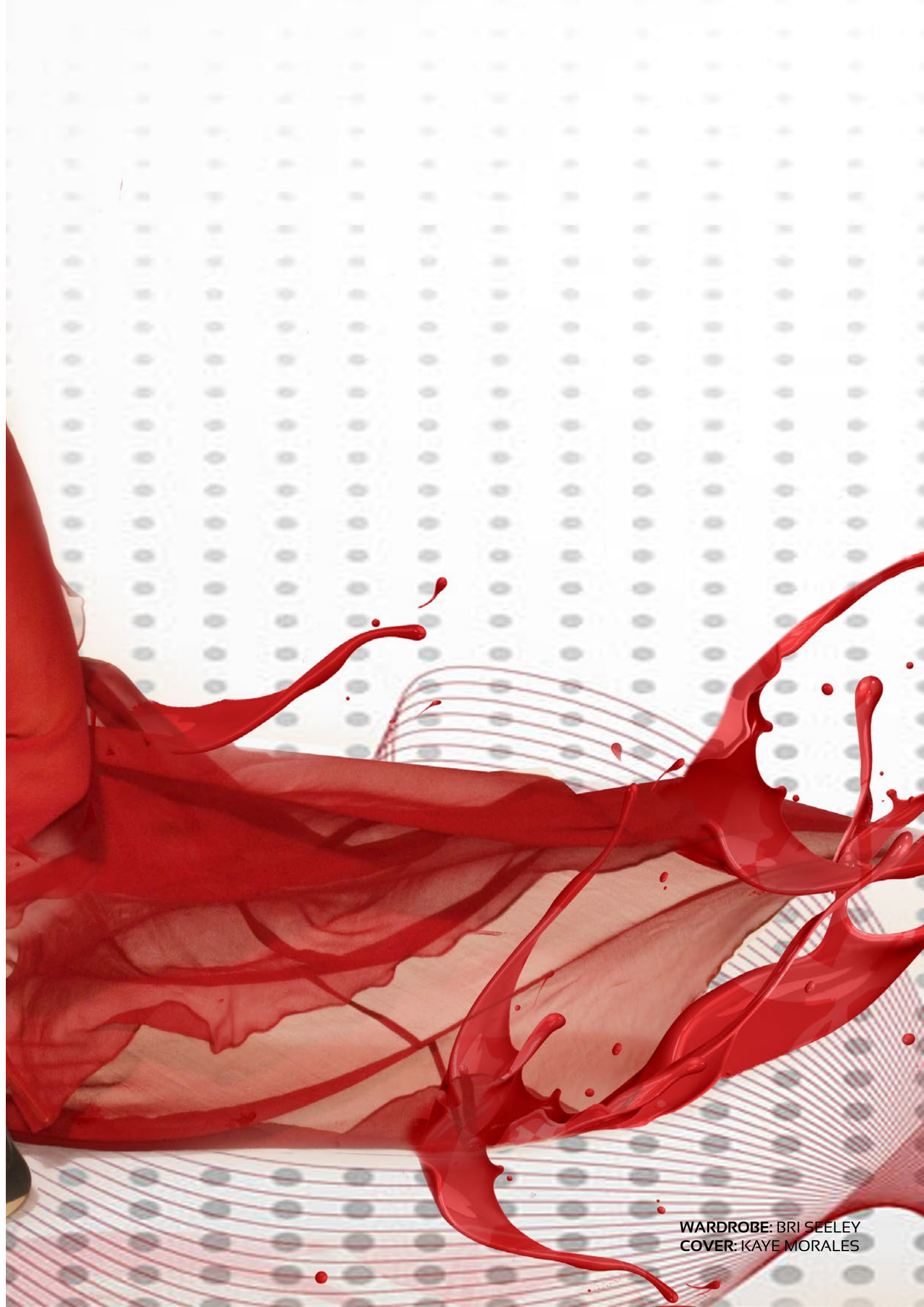

BEAUTY GUIDE:

TOP 25

BEAUTY TIPS

1. Reduce puffy eyes by splashing eye area with cold water or by applying a cold compress to the face using ice wrapped in a wash cloth.
2. To avoid getting mascara on your eye lid do not lower your head during application.
3. Prime eyelids using moisturizer and foundation in order to keep eye-shadow in place.
4. Apply gold eye-shadow to the inner corner of the eyes as well as just above the lash line in order to make eyes appear more open.
5. If you have dark under eye circles, do not apply mascara on your lower lashes. Doing so will make the area look even darker.
6. When applying concealer or moisturizer use your ring finger. Out of all the fingers the ring finger applies the least amount of pressure.
7. Use brown eyeliner and mascara for a softer daytime look.
8. Prevent pencil eyeliner from smudging by applying powder shadow in the same or a slightly darker tint.



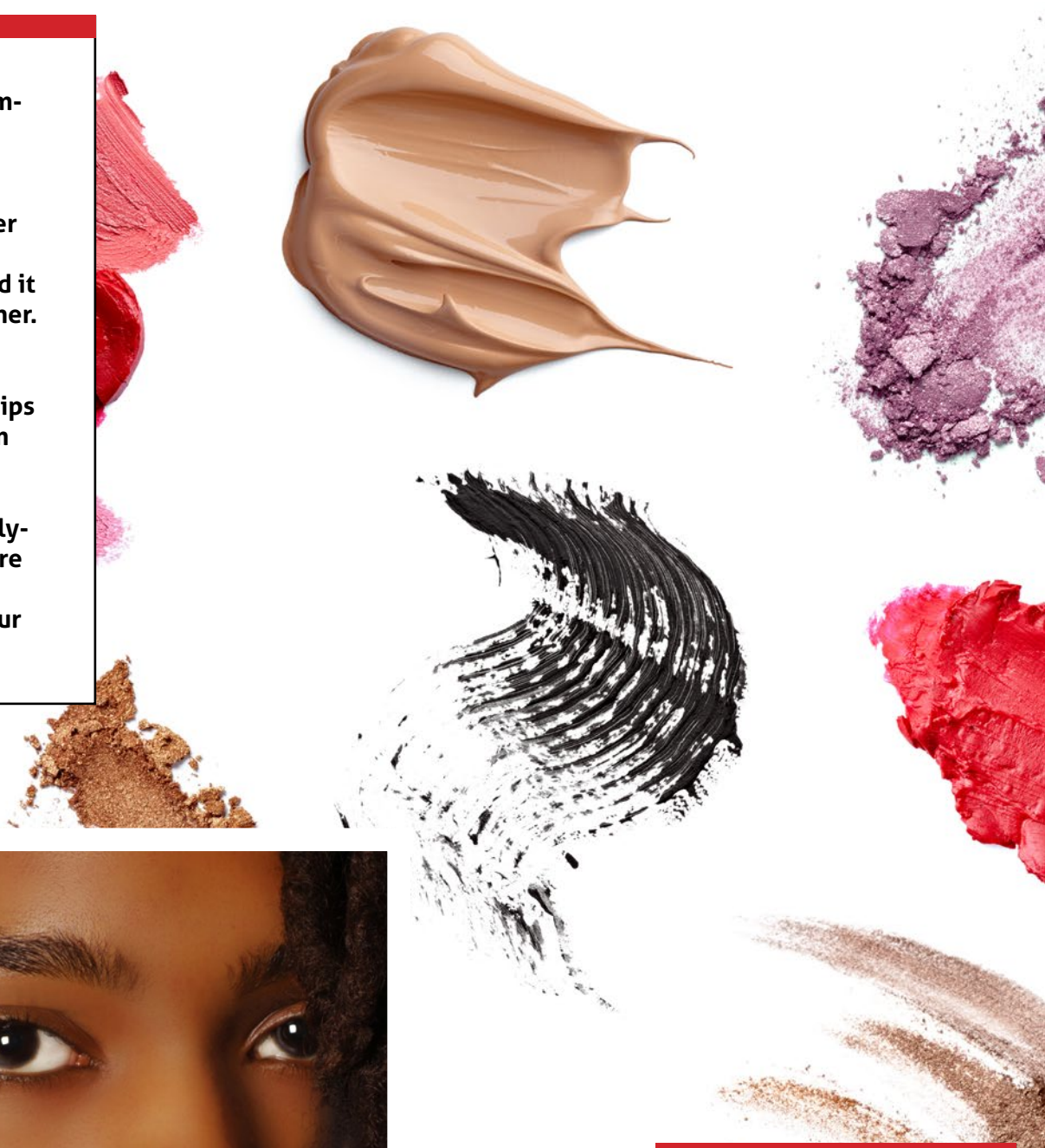
9. Before tweezing, soften skin by dabbing the area with a cotton ball soaked with warm cream or water.
10. Tame unruly eyebrows by spritzing a toothbrush with hairspray and brushing brows upward and outward.
11. Brush hair to help distribute natural oils.
12. If coloring your hair at home, stay within one or two shades to keep drastic issues to a minimum.
13. Rinse conditioner out of tresses with cold water in order to promote shine and seal the cuticle.
14. Use shampoos and conditioners that are sulfate-free on color-treated hair to keep hair healthy and color vibrant.
15. Avoid fake looking eyebrows by only penciling the holes.
16. Avoid touching your face, breakouts can be caused by your own fingers.

17. Do not squeeze pimples you can damage tissue or cause scarring.

18. Warm up lip-liner by pinching it with your fingertips to aid it in gliding on smoother.

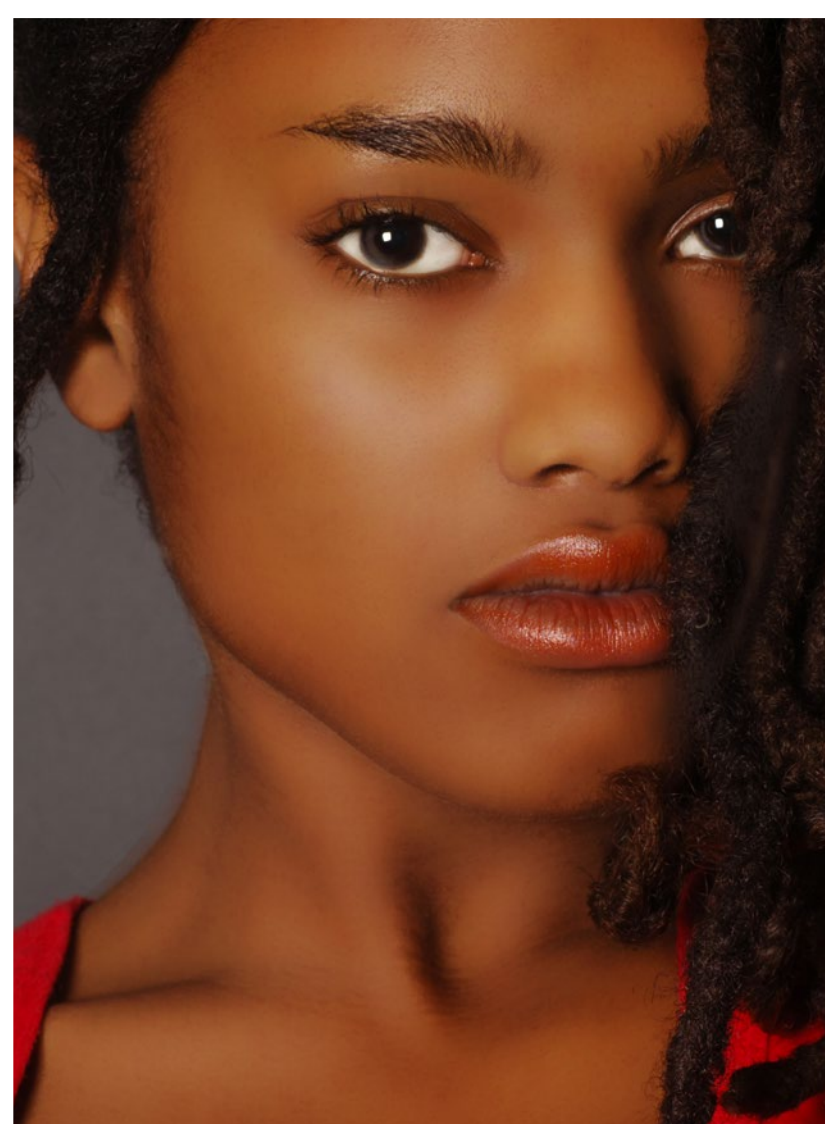
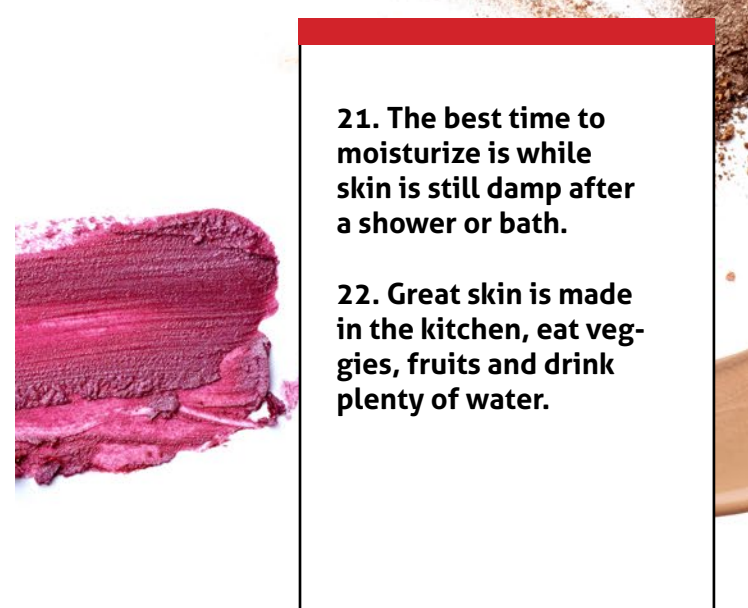
19. Pat a little concealer around your lips to keep lipstick from bleeding.

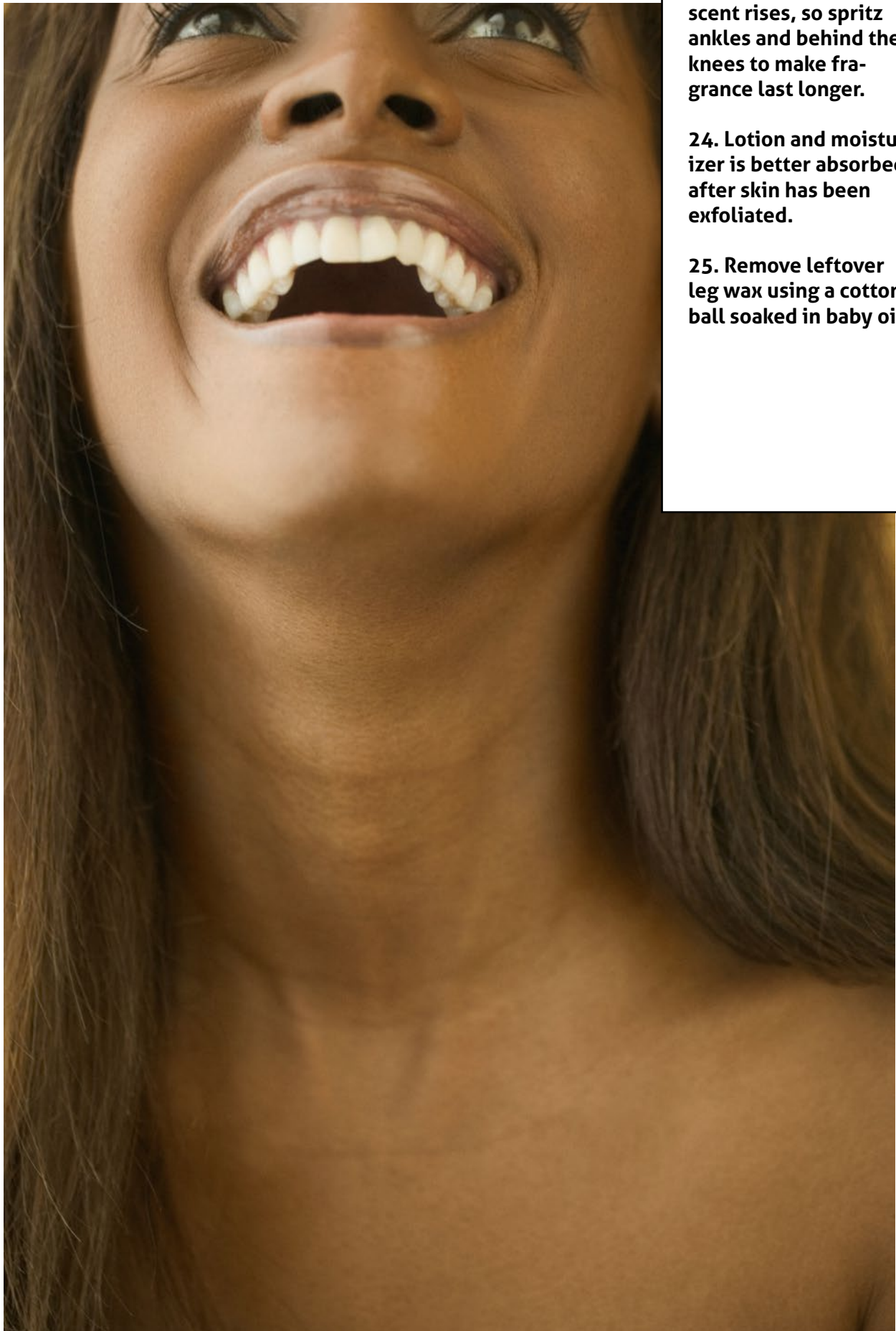
20. Smile when applying lip color to ensure the tint covers the inside corners of your lips.



21. The best time to moisturize is while skin is still damp after a shower or bath.

22. Great skin is made in the kitchen, eat veggies, fruits and drink plenty of water.

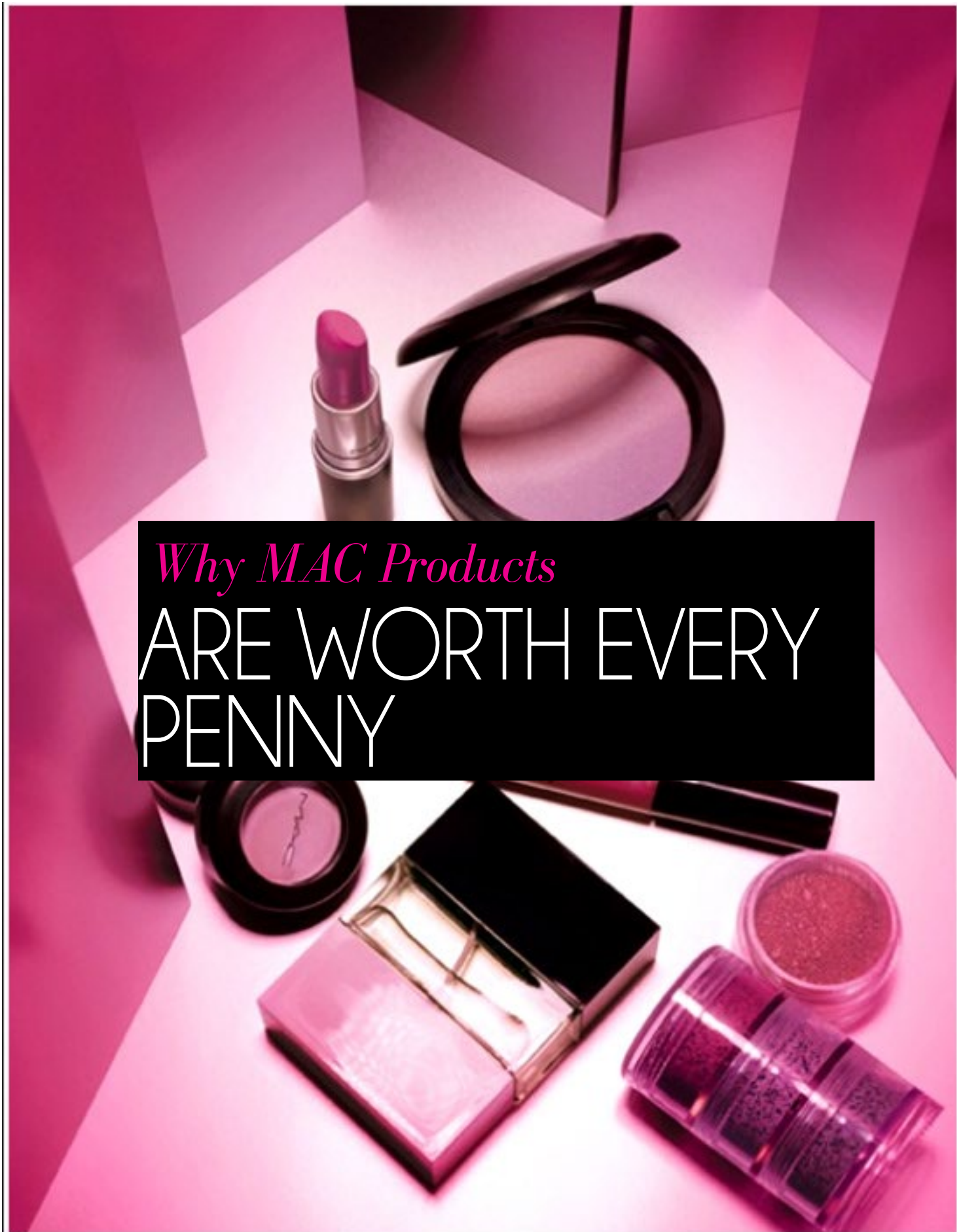




23. Remember that scent rises, so spritz ankles and behind the knees to make fragrance last longer.

24. Lotion and moisturizer is better absorbed after skin has been exfoliated.

25. Remove leftover leg wax using a cotton ball soaked in baby oil.

MAC concealers are available in 6 ranges - Studio Finish (SPF15), Select Cover Up, Select Moisture cover, Studio Sculpt Concealer, Pro Longwear, and Mineralise. While choosing a concealer, bear in mind your skin type, shade and undertones.





Blushes and Eye Shadows: Who doesn't love a good blush? Most people like a variety of blushes in their makeup kits, and whether cream or powder, mineral or long wearing MAC has 'em all! MAC blushes are easy to use and available in a variety of colors and textures, from dewy to sheer transparent. And, lets face it, when it comes to eye shadows, you can never own enough. 4. Always remember to apply a small amount then build for more intensity. It is easier to add color than it is to remove it.

5. Don't use the small free brushes included in blush products; for best application it is best to use a big fluffy blush brush.

Is There **LEAD IN**
YOUR FAVORITE LIPSTICK?



Is there poison in your cosmetics? There may be lead in your lipstick!

You need to check for several things when buying lipstick. Check to confirm it is cruelty free and is not tested on animals, that it does not contain lead or parabens and that it is a lipstick made with healthy ingredients.

While lipstick with lead in it sounds outrageous, when you think about it, it makes sense companies would try to use it. Lead makes color adhere and stay put longer on your lips. That's why they used it in paint for so long. This raises the question of why it's not allowed in paint anymore, but manufacturers are still allowed to put it in a product you put on your lips and ingest on a daily basis.

Lead is a highly toxic heavy metal that stays in the body and is now known to cause serious neurological problems. Lead poisoning in children led to the banning of lead paint back in 1978! Again, why is lead still allowed in lipstick? It's because of the way cosmetics are regulated. Because lead in lipstick is a contaminant, not an actual ingredient, you won't see it listed as an ingredient on a label. You are using poisonous lipstick, and they don't need to let you know because of this labeling loophole.

If you think the incidence of lipstick with lead is rare, keep in mind that in 2009, the FDA tested 20 lipsticks; they found lead in all of them!

If you think you don't use that much lipstick and it won't hurt you, consider that lipstick is just the tip of the iceberg. We are bombarded every day with so many chemicals that our bodies are on overload with exposure to ingredients that are plain bad for us. You need to start eliminating your exposure to these toxins as much as you can, when you can.

Your skin is your largest organ. What are you putting on it that is being absorbed into your body and is causing you harm?





STROKE OF GENIUS

Be a beauty Einstein and always be able to solve any makeup issue before it even begins. It is important to remember that different brushes are used to create different looks or textures. For example, the brush you use to create a smoky eye is quite different from the brush you would use to apply a base or foundation over your entire face. Nevertheless, a set of high-quality brushes will ensure you have every brush needed at a flick of the wrist.

HERE IS A QUICK CHEAT SHEET ON SOME OF THE BRUSHES YOU SHOULD HAVE IN YOUR SET:

- **Angled Brush:** This brush applies eyeliner and is used whenever you need fine lines and maximum control over your hand.
- **Blending Brush:** This particular brush has a small tip with a rounded appearance for blending makeup to a flawless finish.
- **Powder Brush:** This brush is used to apply powder makeup products over the entire surface of the face.
- **Foundation Brush:** This firm, flat brush applies foundation over the entire face evenly.
- **Brow Brush:** This small, angled brush with firm bristles is used to fill in the eyebrows.
- **Lip Brush:** This diminutive brush is used to apply lipstick.

THE PROS AND CONS OF A

VIXEN SEW-IN EXTENSION



New trend alert! Vixen Sew-in Extension! This seems to be the new request of the extensionistas these days. Why the rave about Vixen? This new method allows a person to wear her hair in many different styles without the drama of how to hide the extensions when styling. Even though there are many pros to the Vixen there are also some cons to consider.

What is the Vixen Sew-in Extension?

The Vixen is parted and braided in four sections with your natural hair out around each section and around the hairline perimeter. Inside each section the hair is braided and the extensions are sewn to the braided area.

PROS OF THE VIXEN

-Versatile styling: the styling options include half up-half down, two side pony tails, high bun, and even middle or side parting.

CONS OF THE VIXEN

-Too much natural hair out, which eliminates the sew-in from being a protective style.

-If the extension hair is not similar to the natural hair, then blending can be an issue.

HOW TO WEAR THE VIXEN SUCCESSFULLY

-Purchase hair with a similar texture to your natural hair.

-If there is breakage in the leave out, then adjust the partings to braid it.

-Your natural hair must be at least shoulder length for extensions that are 18 inches or longer.

-Do not leave in longer than two months.

The Vixen sew-in extension is a trend that can be fun to style and easy to wear if you keep these things in mind. It is not suggested to continuously install this method, rather rotate between other installation methods. If you are not sure if this is the right trend for you, consult your hairstylist to ensure you are making the right choice.

You can never go wrong with a good bottle of wine shared with a few friends. No one seems to understand this better than Chrishon Lampley who has fashioned herself into a life-loving wine connoisseur. She has graciously agreed to share her experiences with 1966 and its readers. Going forward she will highlight a wine of the month in each issue of 1966. Following her interview is the wine for May. Salute!



1966: Please tell us what inspired you to open the Three Peas art lounge in Chicago?

Chrishon L: I wanted something different in Chicago that was focused on the arts. Most art galleries serve wine for openings and events, so I thought why not have a winebar designed to help young artists showcase their pieces? Three Peas had a huge following and artists from Hebru Brantley to Max Sansing graced our walls with their pieces. We even had a private label wine at the time called Three Peas Art Wine.

1966: In your opinion how did the Three Peas art lounge prepare you for the wine industry?

Chrishon L: It prepared me tremendously! I built long-lasting relationships with customers, some of which are my best friends and biggest supporters today. I learned what people liked and disliked in certain varietals and what appeals to the masses. I am able to apply that knowledge to Love Cork Screw wine and it helped me develop it into a true lifestyle.

1966: Have you always had a love for wine and what would you say are some of your favorite varietals?

1966: We noticed some of the names of the wine bottles are quite interesting, our personal favorite is “We’re Movin’ on Up”, how did you come up with the different names?

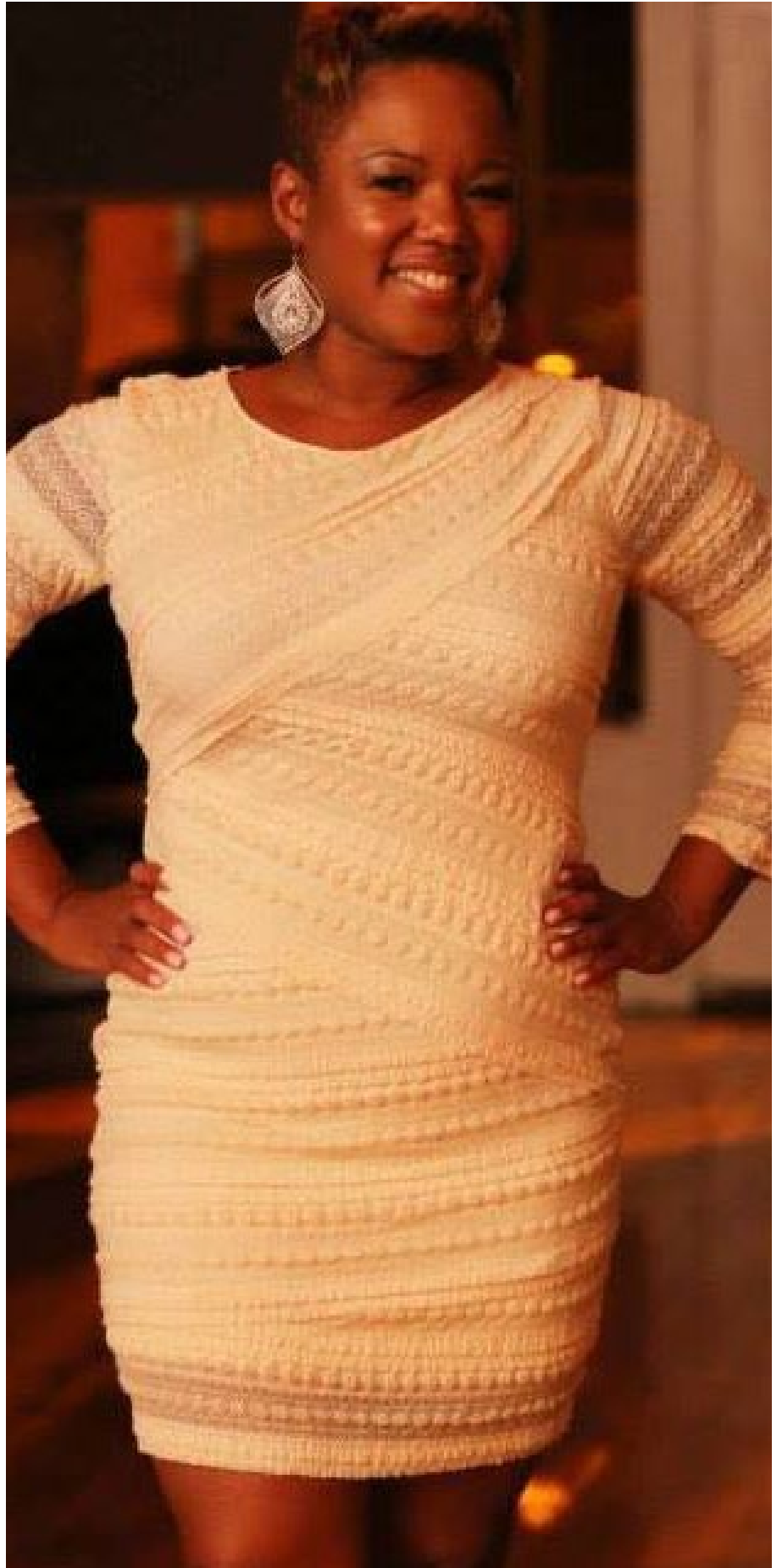

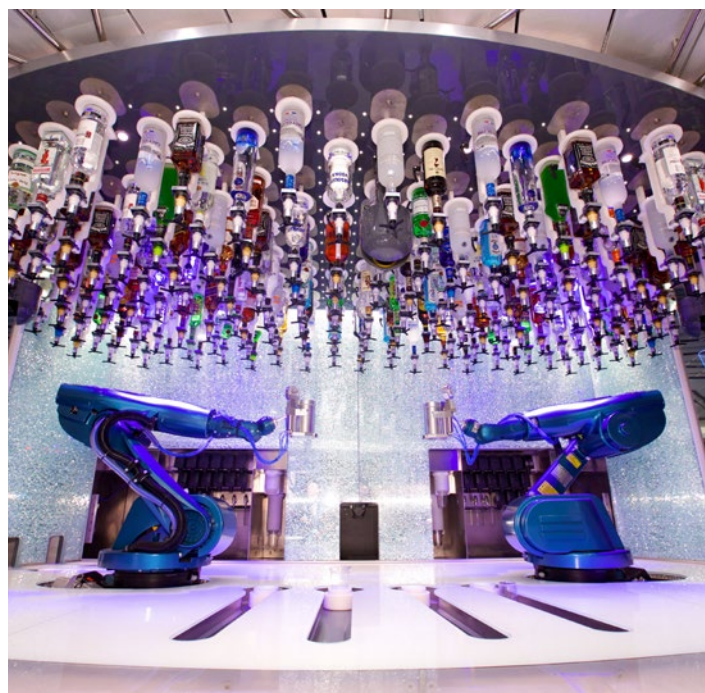


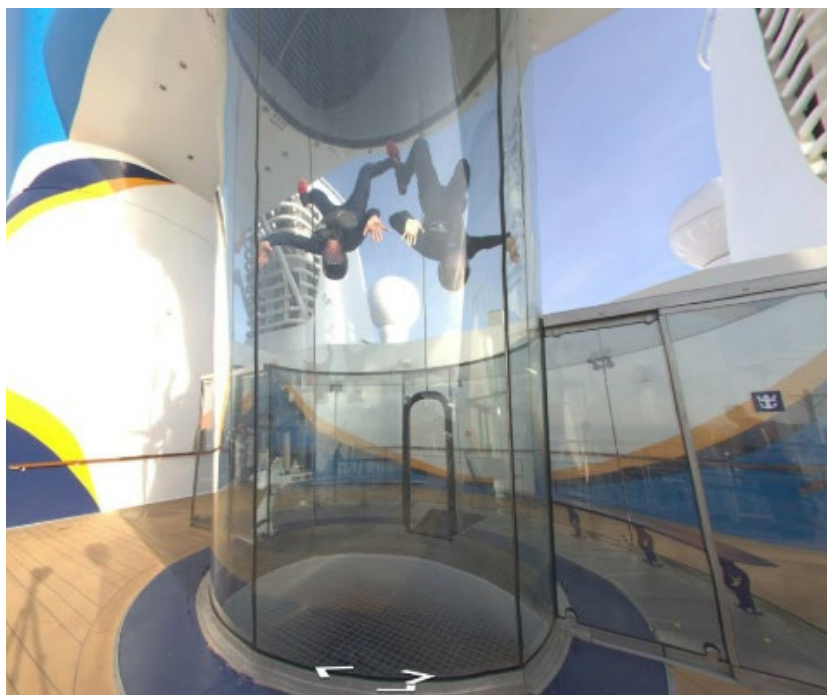
Bionic Bar? Sure, it sounds gimmicky. But the first bar with robot bartenders at sea (or almost anywhere, for that matter) is amazing.

Here are some of the benefits associated with this super nutritious grain:

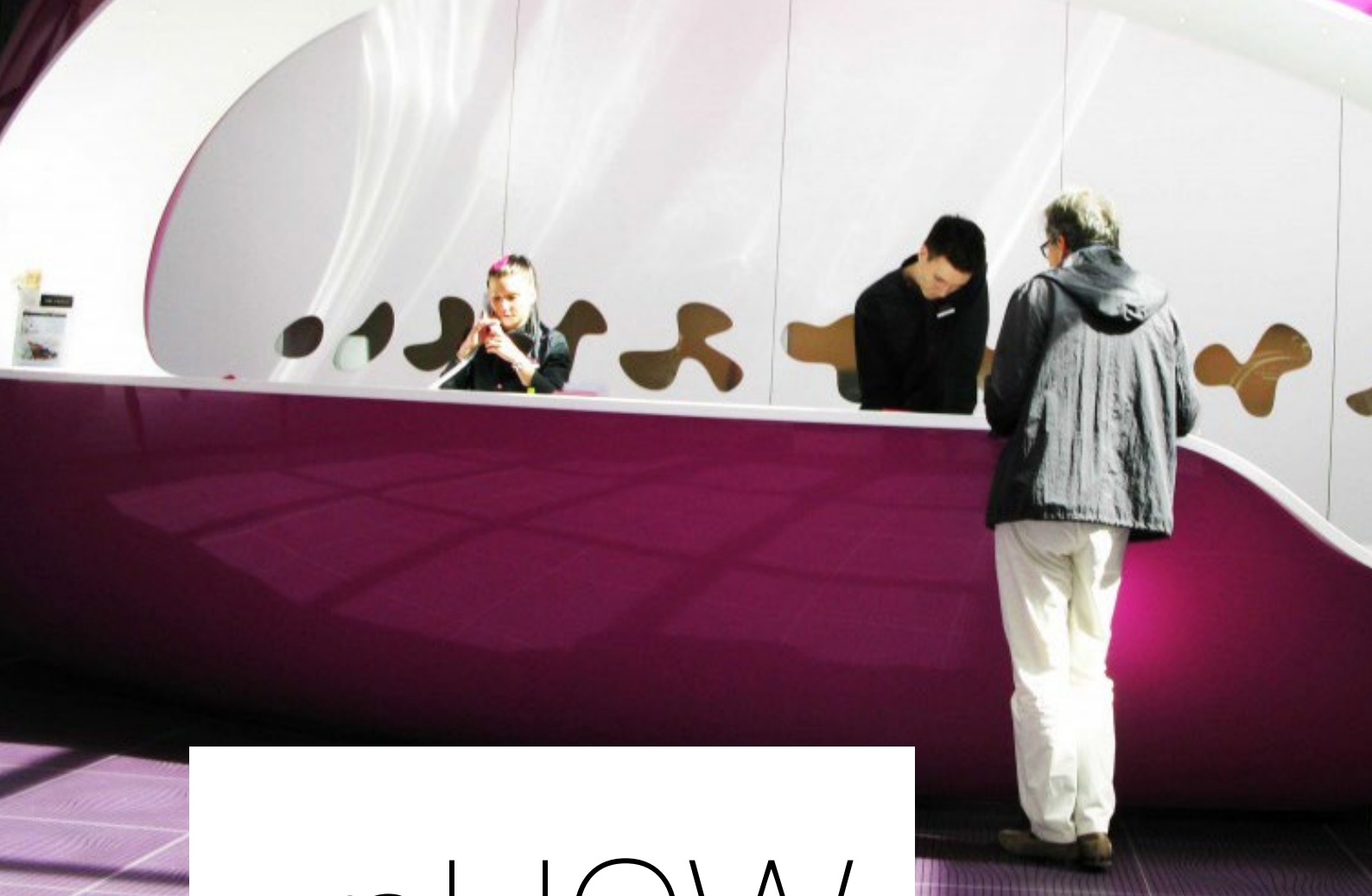
- Quinoa has nearly twice as much fiber as other grains. Fiber of course is good for relieving constipation, reducing high blood pressure and diabetes.

nHOW BERLIN A HOTEL

WITH A SPACE - AGE DESIGN

The nhow Berlin is an offbeat, creative hotel overlooking the River Spree. This futuristic property has a music theme and offers rare amenities like Gibson guitar room service and two recording studios on-site.

The bright colors, psychedelic patterns and funky-shaped furniture have a visual impact in the lobby, bar and restaurant.

The wild decor is somewhat muted in the rooms, though there's still plenty of pink, and quirky furniture, as well as amenities such as iPod docks and TVs embedded in mirrors.



Karim Rashid's vision is a radical design movement whose core principle is to break with old ways of seeing and living and create a world free of nostalgia. Fresh colors, rounded forms and clear lines create spaces that are much more than simply four walls and a ceiling.



The design of the nhow Berlin is a manifestation of a philosophy that allows guests to enter another world for the duration of their stay. A trip to Berlin turns into a sojourn in a new dimension - a positive experience that takes you to the edge.



The architectonic concept involves the trisection of the building in the shape of towers. The East and West Towers on the side of the building, with their irregular clinker facades, incorporate elements of the adjacent, still-standing old warehouse building, while the Upper Tower in the middle (8th to 10th floors) seems to float 118 feet above the Spree River.

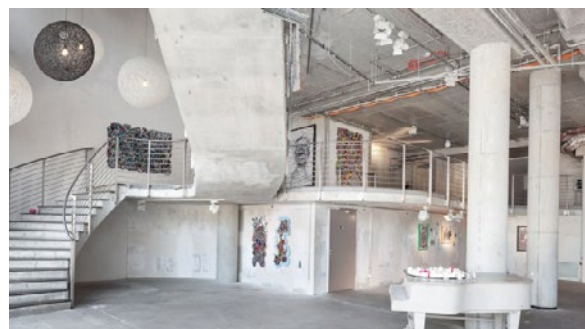
Now Berlin is the second now hotel in the world after Milan. According to the hotel, “they represent a new generation of hotels: offbeat, lively, dynamic and with a local flair that simultaneously has worldwide appeal. Every now Hotel has its own theme in addition to a focus on fashion and art.”

At now Berlin, the common theme replayed all over the

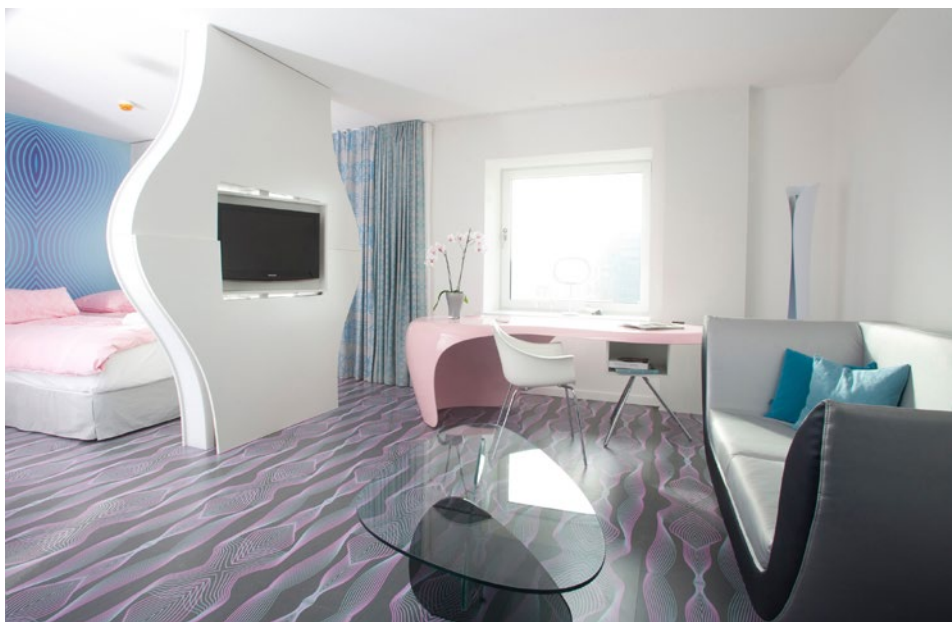

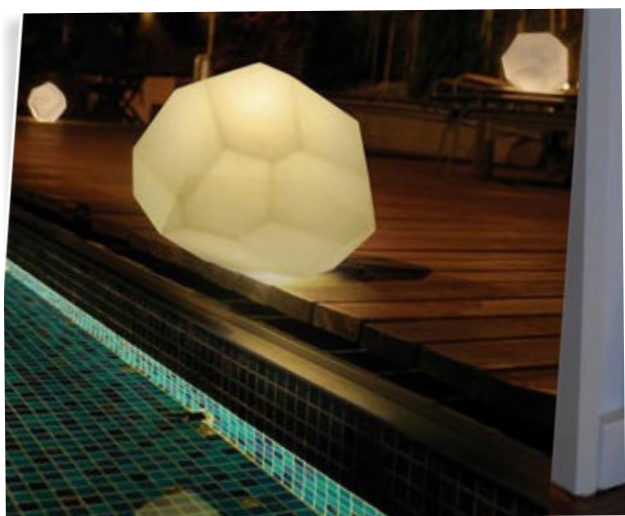
Featured are some futuristic furniture designs that could grace our homes in the not-so-distant future.

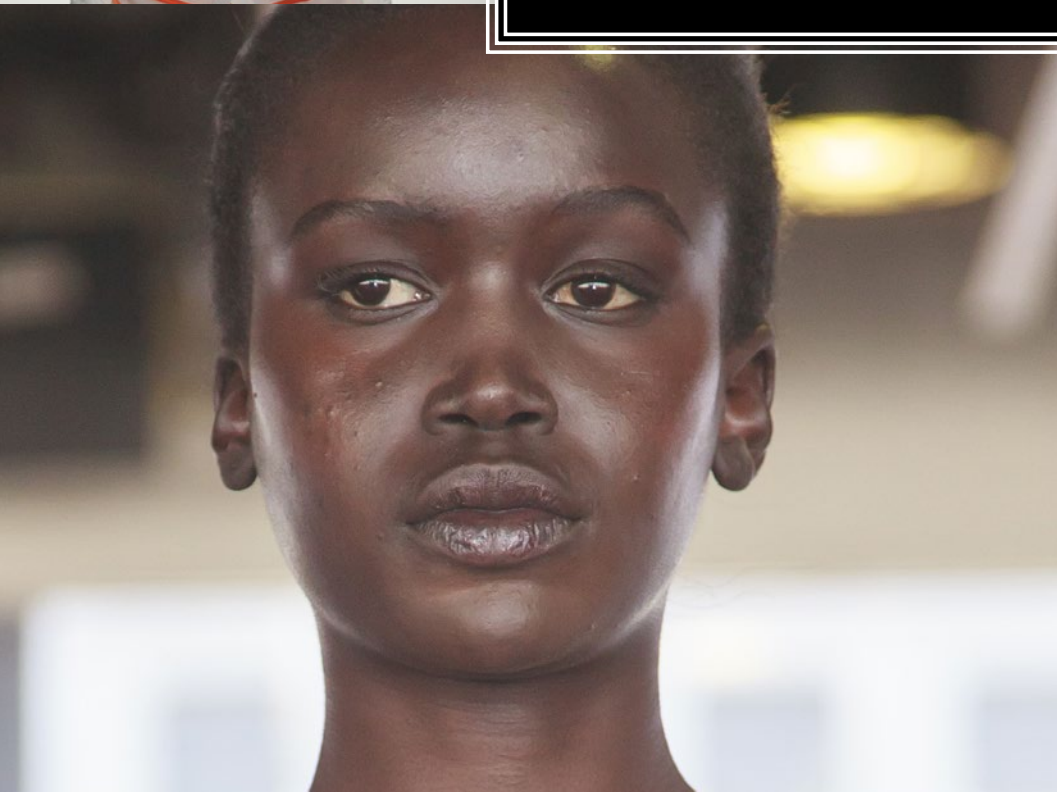


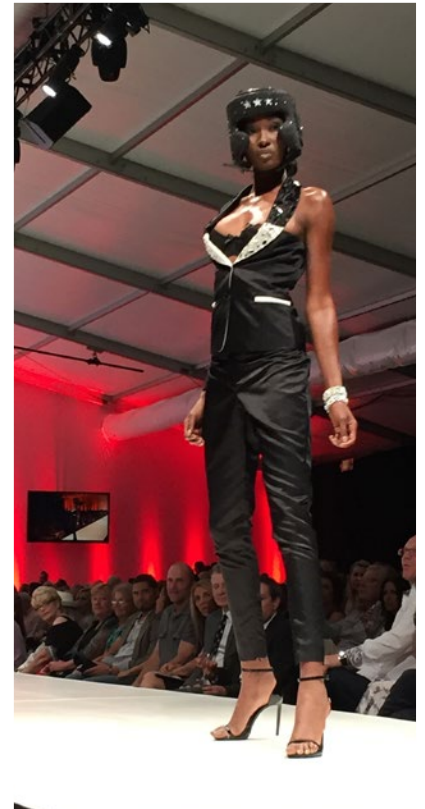
CLOUD COUCH
